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Dear Parent/Guardian/Caregivers:

During the summer of 2019, we began the application process on our City website, www.savannahga.gov/therapeuticapplication; however, you can still pick up applications from the Therapeutic office located at 1815 Lincoln Street or have your application emailed. Please, make sure all the information on your application is complete and correct, if not, your child **will have to be placed on a waiting list** before they can be registered for the quarter. A Confirmation Letter will be sent (by email) or a call will be given **confirming or not confirming** your acceptance and the reason why. If you do not receive a confirmation a week before the program starts, give us a call. **Emails and the Remind app may be sent out as reminders to get your application in before the deadline. Please sign up for “Remind.”**

Food items such as peas, beans, rice and candy will be used this year for our projects. **Please remember if you are not on time, you may have to participate in another activity for that day because we have limited staff and it is difficult to start over, repeat the directions and instructions, and help participants that take longer than others. Caregivers will be asked to come and work with their participant(s).** If your client is unable to attend or be on time, give us a call. So please, be mindful and considerate of the time and the other participants. We want to provide, improve and promote a convenient, affordable, comfortable, accessible, and a safe environment to all of our participants.

Also, we would like to have each participant registered for Special Olympics even if they do not attend. Being registered makes the process easier when athletes are chosen to participate in an event. We would also like to extend an invitation to all parents, guardians, and caregivers to become volunteers with the program and the Special Olympics. We have all the information you need for this process. Attached is a list of all the items needed for our projects for the 2020 year.
